EMBARGO

Sprint & Relay- See Aerial Photo A

St Peters School Campus and Owl Farm are private property, so in general there is no public access to either property. However, there are some areas with public access. Notably the Avantidrome and the Te Awa River Ride. The following restrictions apply to all areas within Aerial Photo A.

Competitors and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competition, are permitted to access the embargoed area (with public access) until further notice. However, use of orienteering maps, orienteering training of all kinds and route choice testing is not allowed in the area. The only exception is for those competitors who may live, work or study within the area covered by the map for running training only while going about their normal daily activity.

A strict embargo applies to the Te Awa River Ride from the Avantidrome to Hall St, Cambridge from Thursday 21 July 2016 until Saturday 23 July 2016. This embargo applies to all competitors and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competition.
